Reception

Reading

Last week and this week your children would have been sent home with their reading diary and a book from their class book corner. The purpose of this is to introduce your children to the routine of bringing a book home from school, sharing it with an adult and bringing it back. This means that when the children start bringing home their reading books they are already in a routine. The reading diaries are for you and us to record when the children have read. It does not have to be a huge amount, just a little note so we are aware of what they have read and how they got on.

More information on reading will be shared with you at the information afternoon.

NumBots information for Year 1 and Year 2



Your child now has a NumBots login in the front of their reading diary. NumBots is an online maths game playable at play.numbots.com or through the numbots app. Playing the game little and often will help support your child's recall and understanding of number bonds and addition and subtraction facts.

There are two game modes when playing NumBots:

- 1. Story Mode the emphasis is on learning the ideas and concepts behind addition and subtraction so it features more diagrams, shapes and question styles.
- 2. Challenge Mode the emphasis is more on speed of recall of key facts, like number bonds to 10, doubling small numbers or adding & taking away in your head.

CHRISTMAS...SORRY!


We tried to hold off mentioning this until October, but sorry, we just couldn't.
