<u>English</u>

The children will be enjoying a range of texts and learning facts about Brunel. Firstly, our English learning will be based around Brunel which links nicely with History this term. Additionally, the children will be reading Amazing Grace and engaging in a multimedia video

called Something Fishy. The focus will still be to continue on building sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops, but with the addition of using creative nouns and adjectives.



<u>PSHE</u>

Lessons will examine and explore the idea of home what makes a home to different people and animals, alongside celebrating the diversity found across each of our homes. This term we will also spend time exploring mental health in Children's Mental Health Week.

<u>Maths</u>

Our Maths learning will be continuing the unit of place value (to 20) and Addition and Subtraction to 20. The children will be continuing to develop their use of number lines and other mathematical resources to help them solve a wide of range <u>of questions</u>.

<u>Science</u> The main theme of our science lessons this term is Materials. We will be identifying and classifying materials, as well as making observations of a range of materials over time.

We will also be continuing our work on the weather and think about seasonal change, observing and discussing the elements of Winter.



<u>Design & Technology</u>

The children will be involved in making cars using shoe boxes. They will have the opportunity to design, make and evaluate their cars. Children will also be involved in testing their cars out in class races. Please can you bring a good size shoe box ready for the WB of week 5. Parents, we would like to invite you to join us for a fun morning in creating these cars. <u>Music</u>

WATER:

We will listen to, create, perform and review water – themed music, using our voices expressively to sing rhymes. <u>Local Study</u>: Who is Brunel and what was his impact on Bristol? We will begin by asking the questions 'Who was Brunel, why is he famous and how is he connected to Bristol?'. We will discuss his achievements and the impact of his designs locally, nationally and internationally.
