Message from Mr Jones

On behalf of the Ashton Gate school community, I would like to send our condolences to the families and friends of the two young men who lost their lives last weekend in south Bristol. This tragic incident has sent shockwaves through the city and the police and Local Authority have been very proactive in keeping school leaders updated. As part of this, I have been asked by the city's Safeguarding in Education Team to share the following statement with you all;

As we come together as a City to try to deal with, process and ultimately avoid a repeat of the tragic events of Saturday 27 January, it would be helpful if you could monitor closely your child's social media activity. We are aware of unhelpful social media posts circulating, which are largely sharing misinformation or rumouring. Whilst we do not for one moment think that our children are the source of the posts, we advise that under no circumstances should they share, like or comment on such posts. We also strongly recommend that they remove themselves from any groups where such posts are being shared.



Did you know...?

Last year £9000 of PTA fundraising provided play therapy sessions for children needing help with their speech and language.

Gareth Jones, Executive Headteacher, said this about the PTA's contribution:

"Support for speech and language is the most common additional therapy that primary schools access. The funding from the PTA helps pay for a day per week of a fully qualified speech and language therapist in school. The therapist supports individual children, and their families, and has a huge impact on the development of the pupils."

"The therapist works in collaboration with our NHS provider, and the impact is that significantly more pupils are having issues with speech and language delay and development addressed much more rapidly."

We are always speaking to the school about where best to channel the funds that you all help the PTA to raise. We look forward to working with them on exciting projects in 2024.
