## Questions and answers

### What is the school uniform?

- Plain white or royal blue shirts/ polo shirts
- Royal blue jumper, sweatshirt or cardigan. These should be plain or feature the school logo.
- Plain black or grey trousers, shorts, skirts or dresses
- Blue and white checked dresses, normally worn in warmer weather
- Plain navy blue, grey or black tights or leggings.
- Flat shoes, black and appropriate for school.

### What is the PE uniform?

- Plain white or blue t-shirt
- Black shorts / leggings / jogging bottoms
- Black trainers
- No jewelry

### What are the school dinner options?

Children can also bring in their own healthy packed lunch from home.

### How do I pay for school dinners?

All school dinners are paid on Parent pay. Please sign up to parent pay app through the school office.

### Can my child bring in a snack for break?

Yes they can bring in a **healthy snack**.

Please be aware that some children have nut allergies.

We also encourage pupils to bring in their own water bottle and there is also an option to pay for milk.

### What does my child need to bring into school with them?

In KS2 (Years 3,4,5 & 6) children will need to bring in a rucksack that will carry their reading record diary (year 3 & 4 only) and water bottles. We encourage the children to keep their PE kits in school and take home at the end of a term.

### What time does school start?

Year 3: 8.30 children enter through the main doors at the front of Upton site.

Year 4: 8.40 children enter through the black gate to the left of the building.

Year 5 : 8.40 children enter through the white side door next to the gate.

Year 6: 8.30 children enter through the white side door.
