This is how we stay safe when we use computers:

I will ask permission before entering any Web site, unless my teacher has already approved that site.

I will not look at or delete other people's files.

I will not bring memory storage devices into school without permission.

I will only e-mail people my teacher has approved using the group email address. The messages I send will be polite and sensible.

When sending e-mail, I will not give my home address or phone number, or arrange to meet someone.

I will ask for permission before opening an e-mail or an attachment.

I will only do activities that a teacher or suitable adult has told or allowed me to use.

I will take care of the computer and other equipment.

I will ask for help from a teacher or suitable adult if I am not sure what to do or if I think I have done something wrong.

I will tell a teacher or suitable adult if I see something that upsets me on the screen.

I know that the school may check my computer files and many monitor the Internet sites I visit.

I know that if I break the rules I might not be allowed to use a computer.
