Phonics

In phonics this term we will begin teaching the children single letter sounds and the skills they will need for reading simple CVC words.

In the first week your child will be sent home with their reading wallet, reading diary and a reading for pleasure book, this will be a story book that they are borrowing from the library for you to share with them at home (this is not your child's school reading book).

Following this, in week 2, the children will come home with their first official school reading book. This will be a wordless book and more information on how to use this book will be put in the weekly school newsletter at a closer date.

Maths

In maths this term we will be exploring: subitising, counting and ordering numbers, how numbers are made, comparing numbers, and exploring pattern. We will explore these areas both indoors and outdoors. We will be introducing the children to our Ashton Gate maths habits.



Things to bring:

We aim to take the children outside in all weathers. As an option you can bring in wellies and a puddlesuit which can be kept at school.

All about me box

In week 5 the children will start to take turns to bring home the all about me box. This will be an empty shoebox for the children to fill with things that are special to them, which they will then share with the class.

Inside the lid of the box, there will be information on what sorts of things the children can put inside.

Kitchen Disco

In week 7 we will be looking at the book 'Kitchen Disco' as part of learning about pattern in Maths. On Friday 17th October we will be having a kitchen disco at school during the school day, we will invite the children to come to school dressed in the colour of their favourite fruit. We will be making fruit headbands at school for the children to wear.

Information

- Once your child has started school you will be given a letter explaining how you can create an account for your child on Parentpay. It is very important that you do this as soon as possible so that you are able to order lunches, receive letters and communication from school and pay for any trips.
- Just a reminder that once the children are in for full days, although the start time for Reception is 8.50, the doors to the classroom open at 8.40 and you are able to drop your child to school in this 10 minute slot. This gives your child's teacher time to individually welcome your child and ensures that all children are in ready to learn. You can also pass on any information you need to at this time to the teacher.

Meet & Greet

Early on this term, there will be a chance to see inside your child's classroom. During this session, your child's teacher will give a short presentation about the curriculum in Reception and you will have a chance to ask them questions. The presentation will explore teaching and learning in all the areas of the EYFS curriculum. There will be more information about the timing of this very soon.

Snack

Children are given free fruit every day and milk until the term they turn 5 (after this you will get a letter from the dairy and you have the option to pay for milk). We also offer the children a savoury cracker to keep them going during the day and ask for a voluntary contribution for this of £18 for the year, or feel free to split this into smaller instalments each term if you wish. This can be given to your child's teacher (in cash please, we can't accept cheques).

PE

We will begin PE in W/C 29th September when the children have settled into school.
