### English

In Phonics, we will be continuing with our phonics programme 'Little Wandle', building on the reading skills learnt in previous terms. We will regularly visit the library and share a wide variety of books to encourage a love of reading.

In English, we will be developing writing skills through enjoying a range of texts including 'There is a Rang-Tan in my bedroom' and 'Dear Green Peace' and 'Someone swallowed Stanley'.

### Maths

In Math, we will continue the term with developing a deep understanding of numbers from 20 to 50. Children will learn to solve mathematical problems and represent numbers in a variety of ways through practical activities, both inside and outside, as well as using stories, pictures and songs.



### Science

Children will be continuing to use their new skills such as observing, comparing and classifying, which will be applied through the various topics each term.

This term, the children will continue to be learning about materials and their properties.

As part of our science week, we will be conducting some practical science tasks and also immersing the children in various science activities through the week.



## PSHE

We will explore our friendships and money. Then we will be learning about differences and similarities between girls and boys.

## Religion and Worldviews

We will be discussing the meaning of caring through the Sikh and Muslim religions.

## DT

We are going to explore different fabrics and we are going to design, create and create our own puppets.

## Art

This term we will look at a wide range of art and design techniques including painting.

## Music

The children will be engaging in singing. This term, the children will be exploring the inter related dimension of music. They will also be exploring sounds of the sea and the correlation between pitch and notation.

## Geography

This term, the children will be learning about the North and South Poles and will be exploring where is hot and cold on Earth.

## History

In term 4, the children will be learning about David Attenborough and what he is famous for and what has he achieved.

## Supporting your child's learning at home

Please continue to read regularly at home with your child. It is really important to read the books more than once to ensure that your child has a thorough understanding of what they are reading and can really enjoy the story by reading it fluently. Reading other books alongside those that come home from school is also fantastic practice and is vital to developing a real love of reading.
