Curriculum

The School will:

- ensure that every child is taught at an appropriate and challenging level by qualified teachers;
- maintain an attractive environment, good materials and equipment and teach the full National Curriculum and religious education;
- provide specialist music tuition and swimming

Parents will:

- encourage their child to participate fully in school activities;
- support their child's learning by attending parents' evenings and performances;
- provide their child with suitable clothing.

Behaviour

The School will:

- make sure children are familiar with school rules;
- use rewards and sanctions fairly;
- make sure that School staff always set a high standard of personal behaviour;
- respect the views of children and parents.

Parents will:

- help their child understand and follow the school rules;
- encourage their child to care for school property both at school and at home;
- behave in a way that sets a good example while on school premises.

The School will:

- try to enable all pupils to take part in all activities;
- celebrate our diverse backgrounds;

- start classes promptly at 8.50am at the Upton Road site and 9.00am at the Ashton Gate Road site;

- contact the school promptly if their child is absent.

Welfare and Communication
